

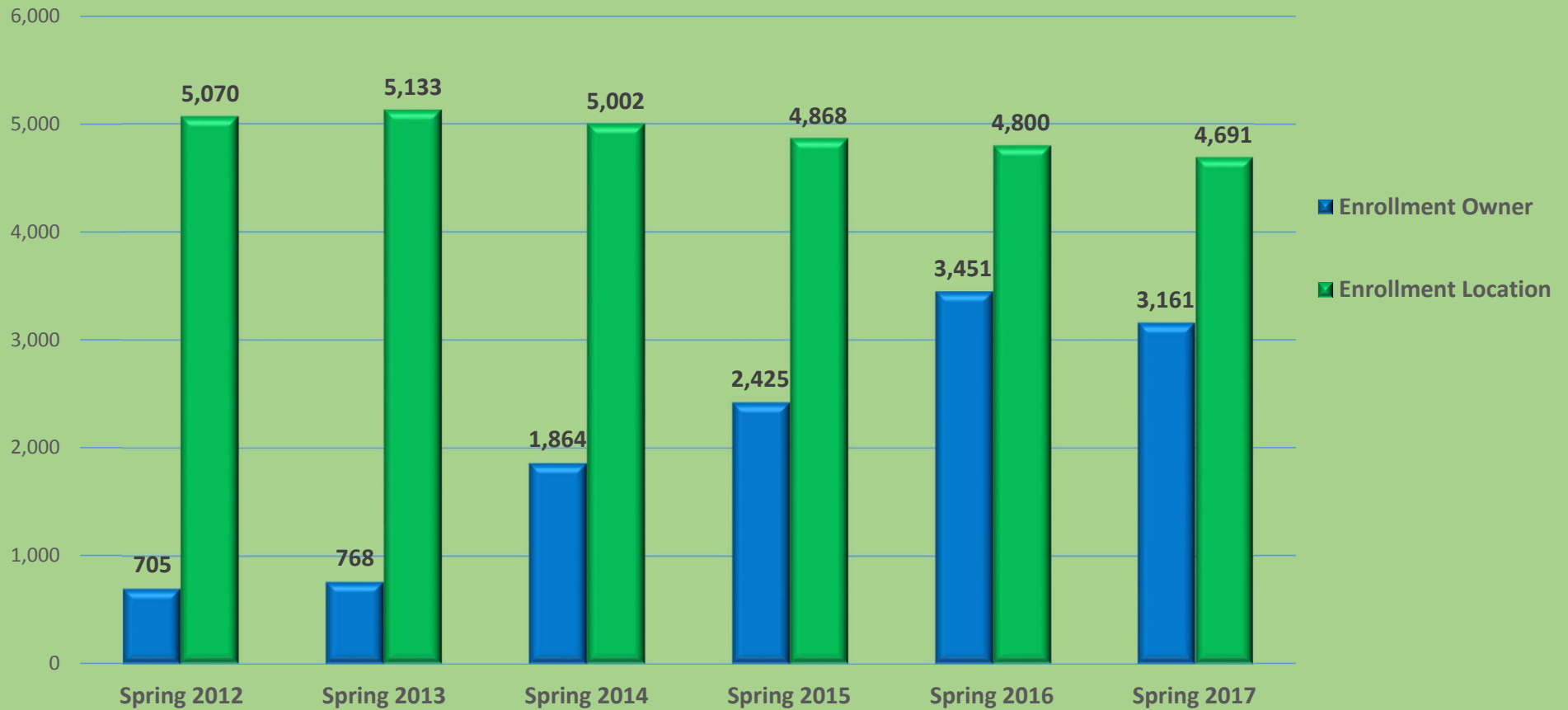

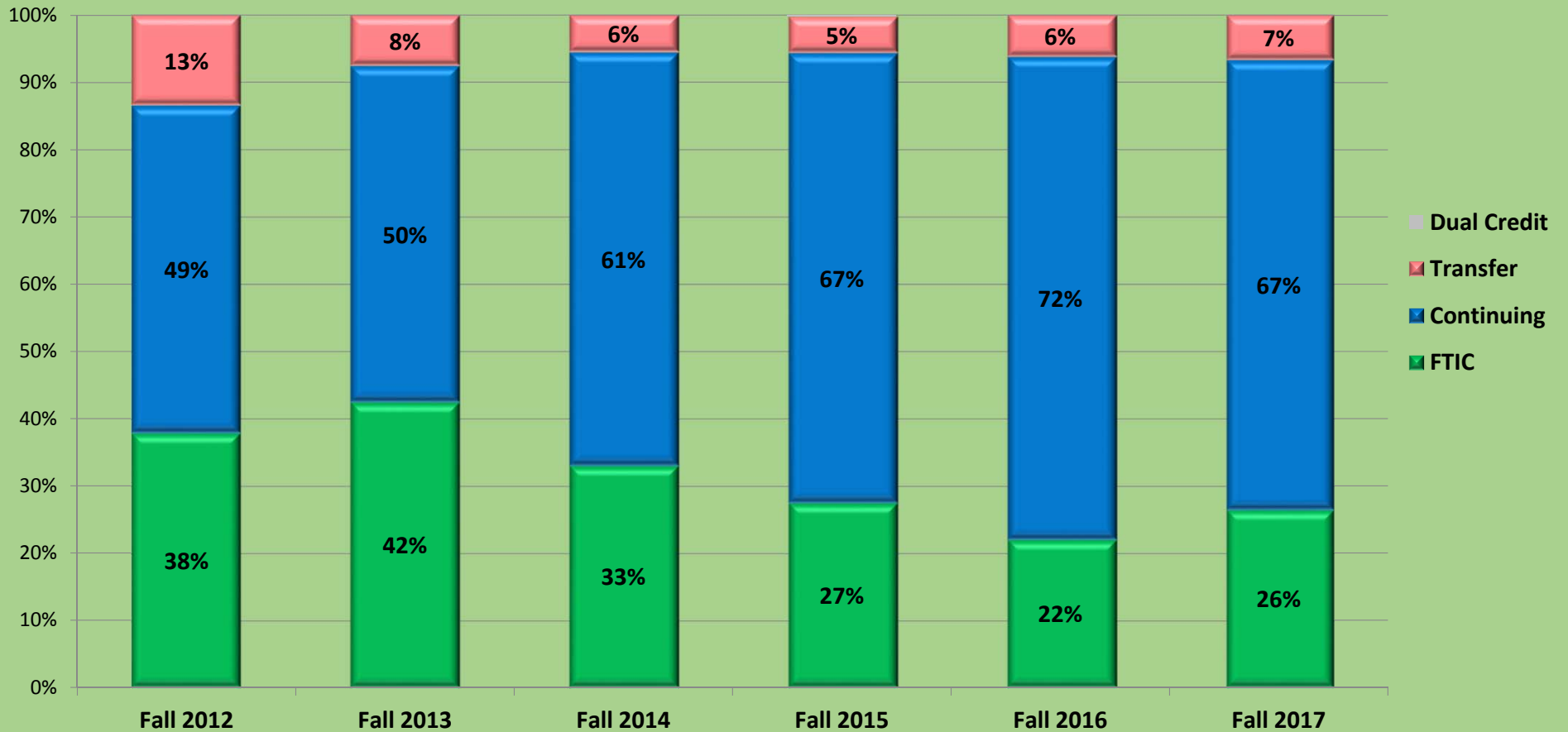
# Fall Enrollment 2012-2017



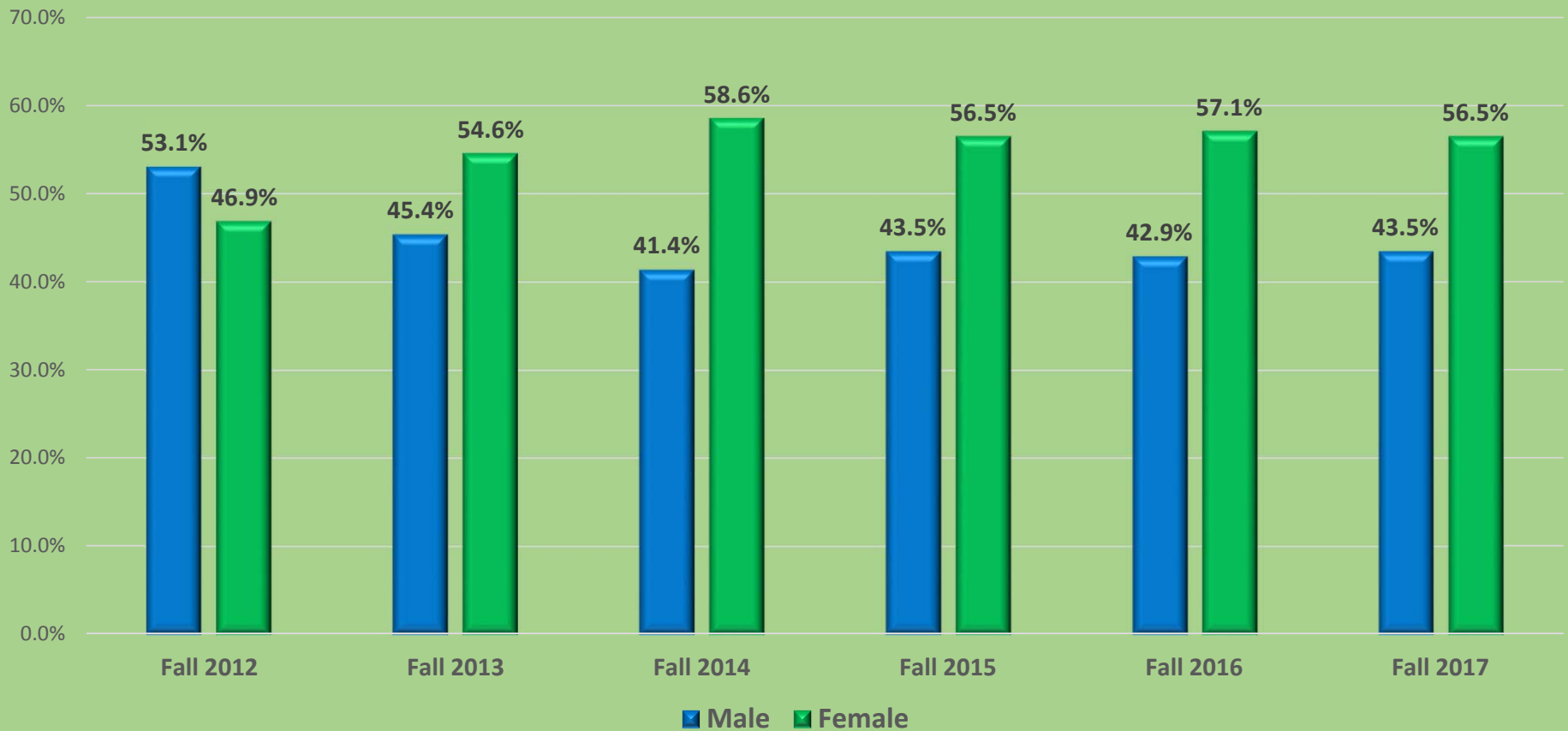
# Spring Enrollment 2012-2017



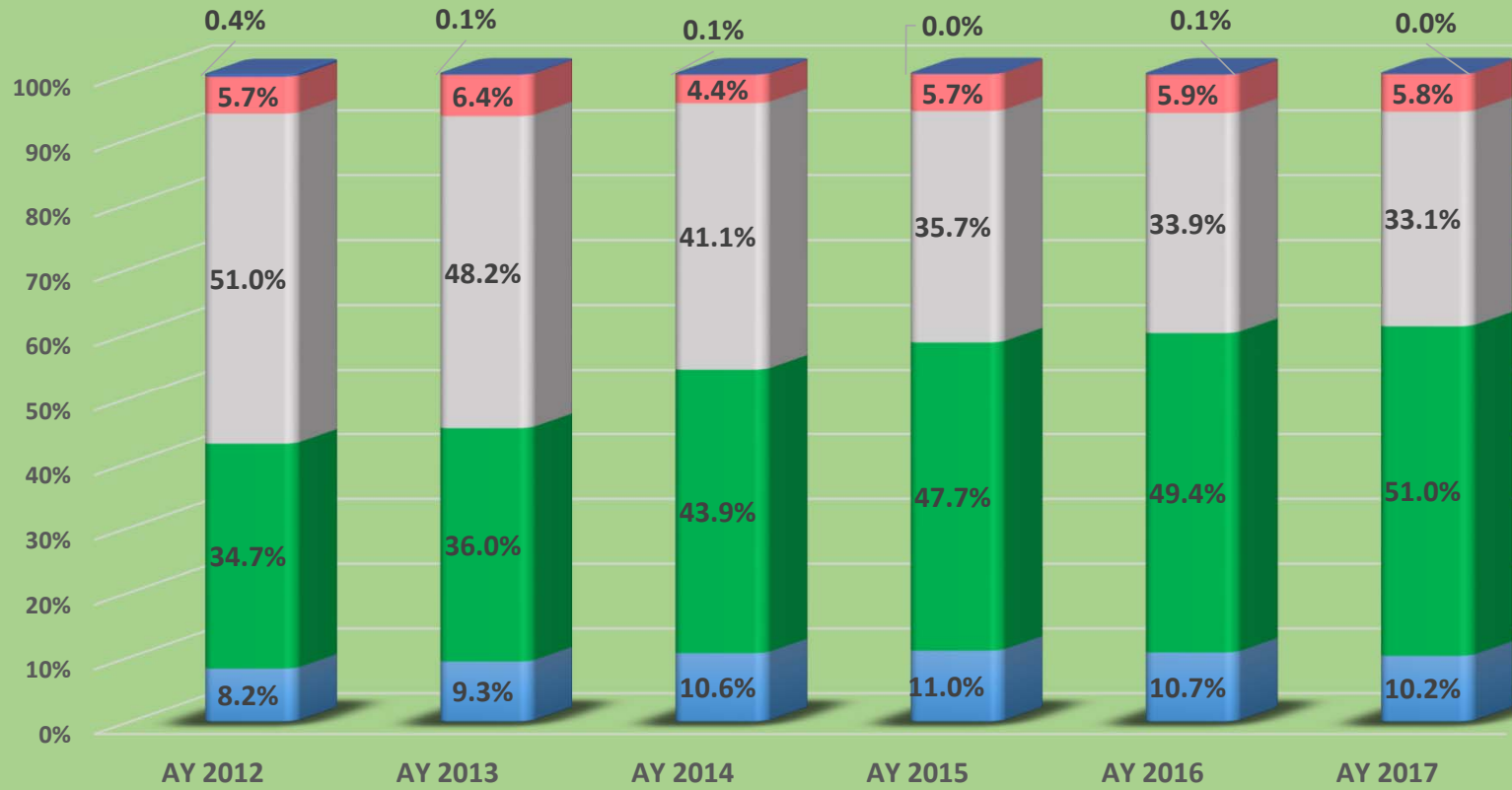
# Fall 2017 Enrollment by Student Type



# NLC Enrollment by Gender

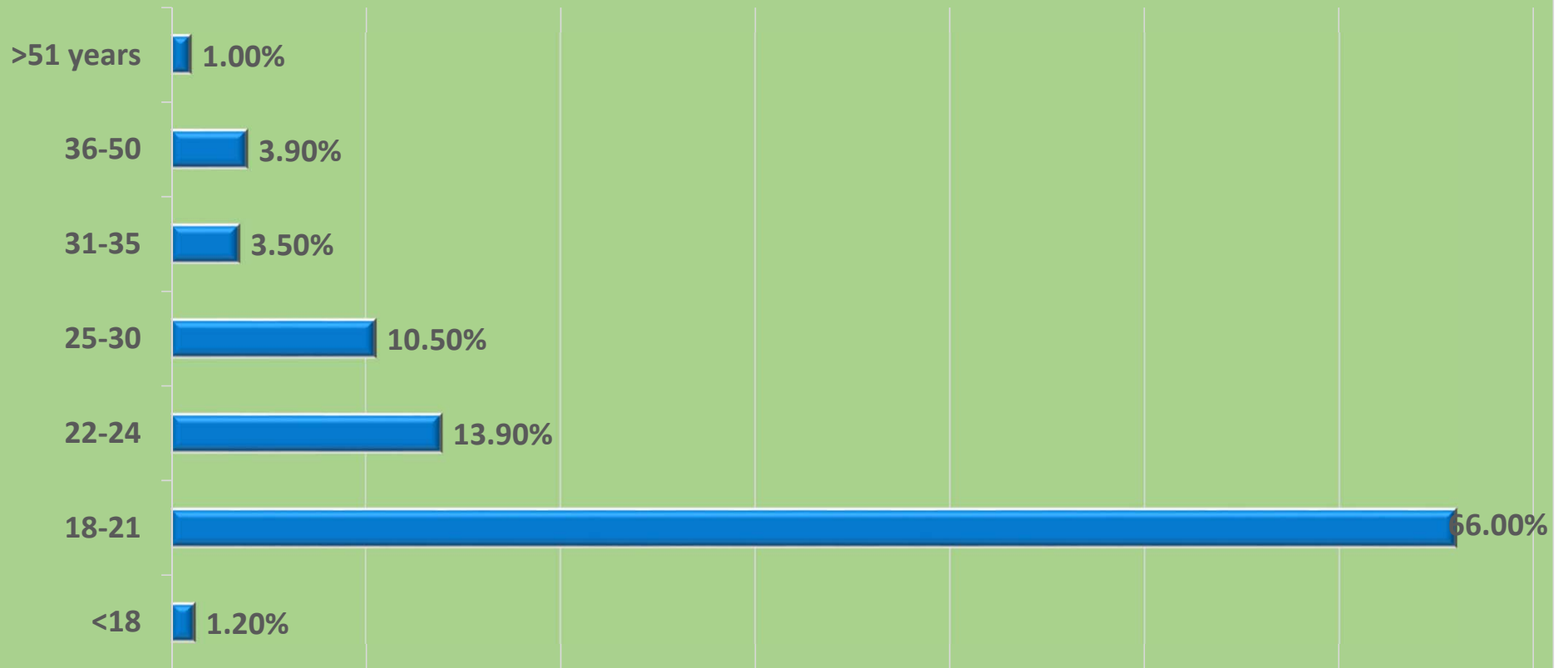


# Percentage of NLC Enrollment By Ethnicity

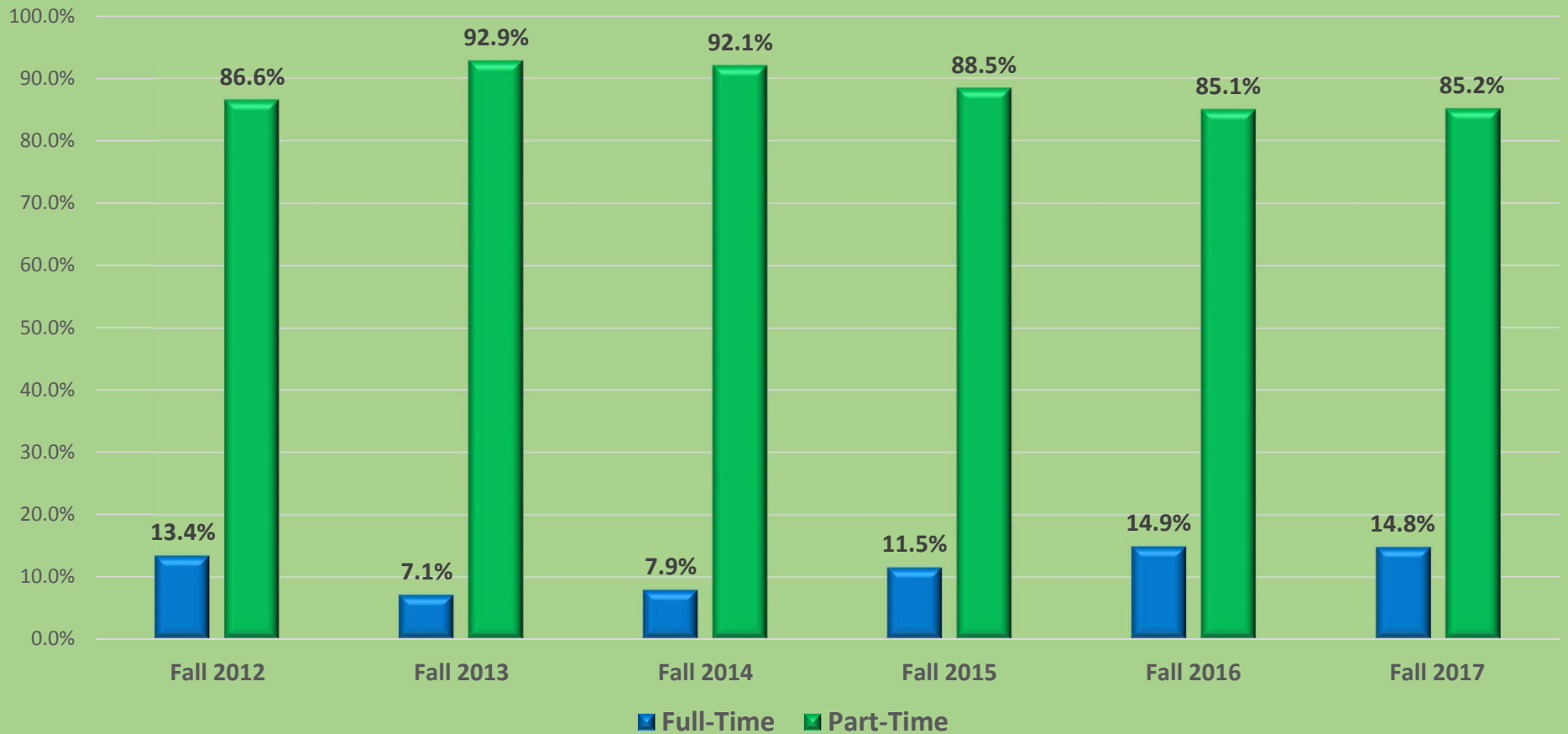

## Fall 2017 Enrollment by Age Category

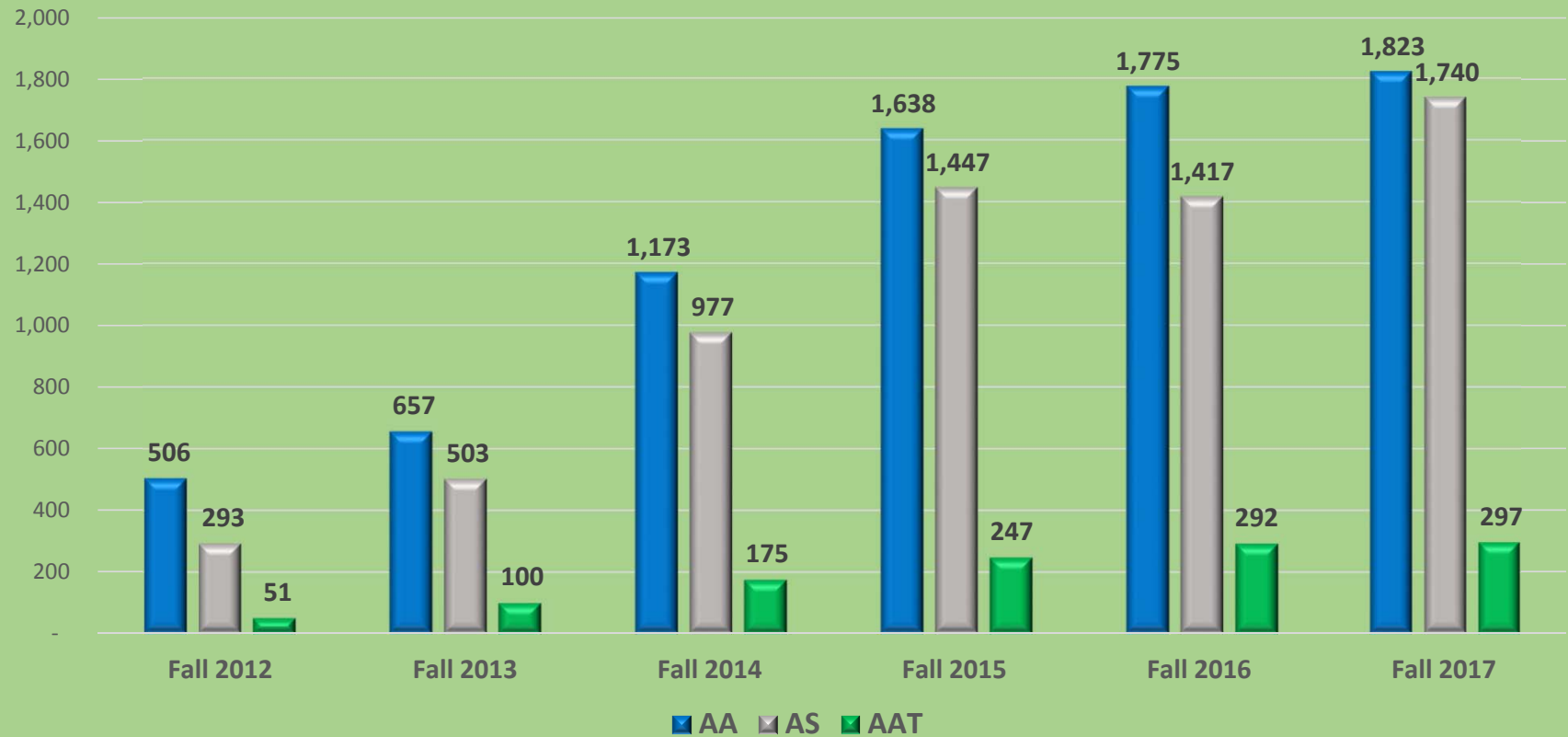


# Percentage of Full-Time Part-Time Students

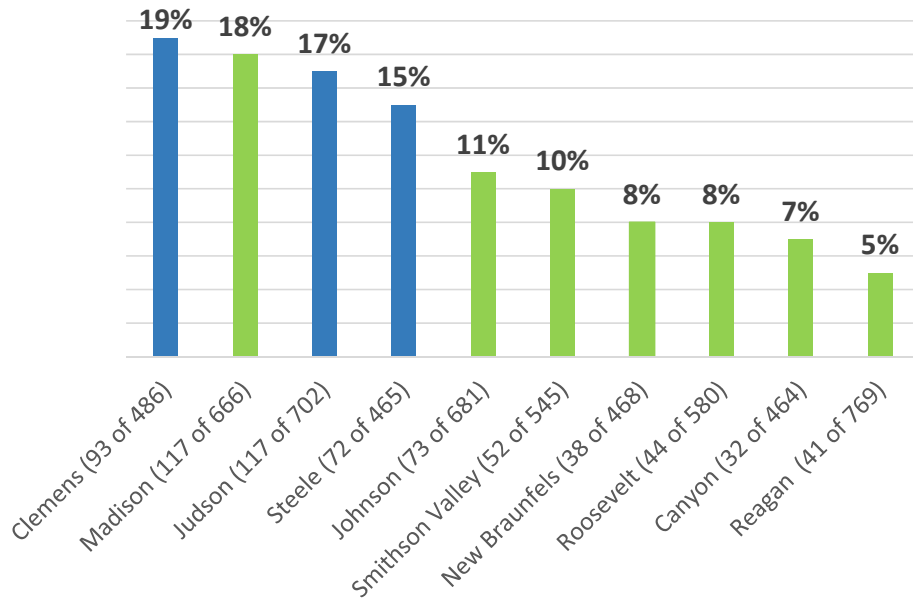




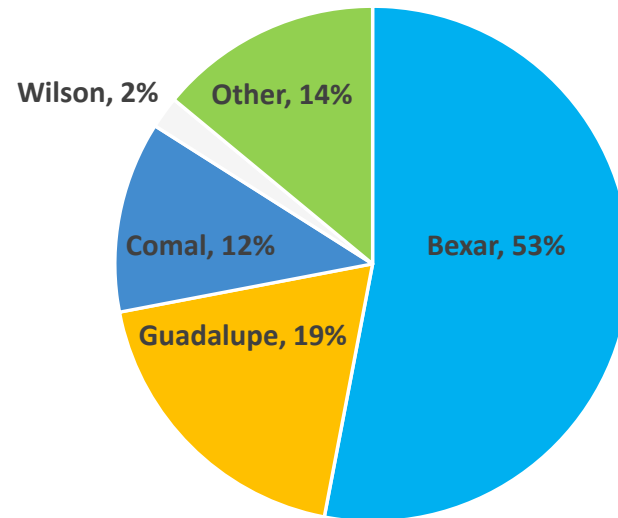
# Enrollment by Academic Degree Program



# High School Sender Schools and County

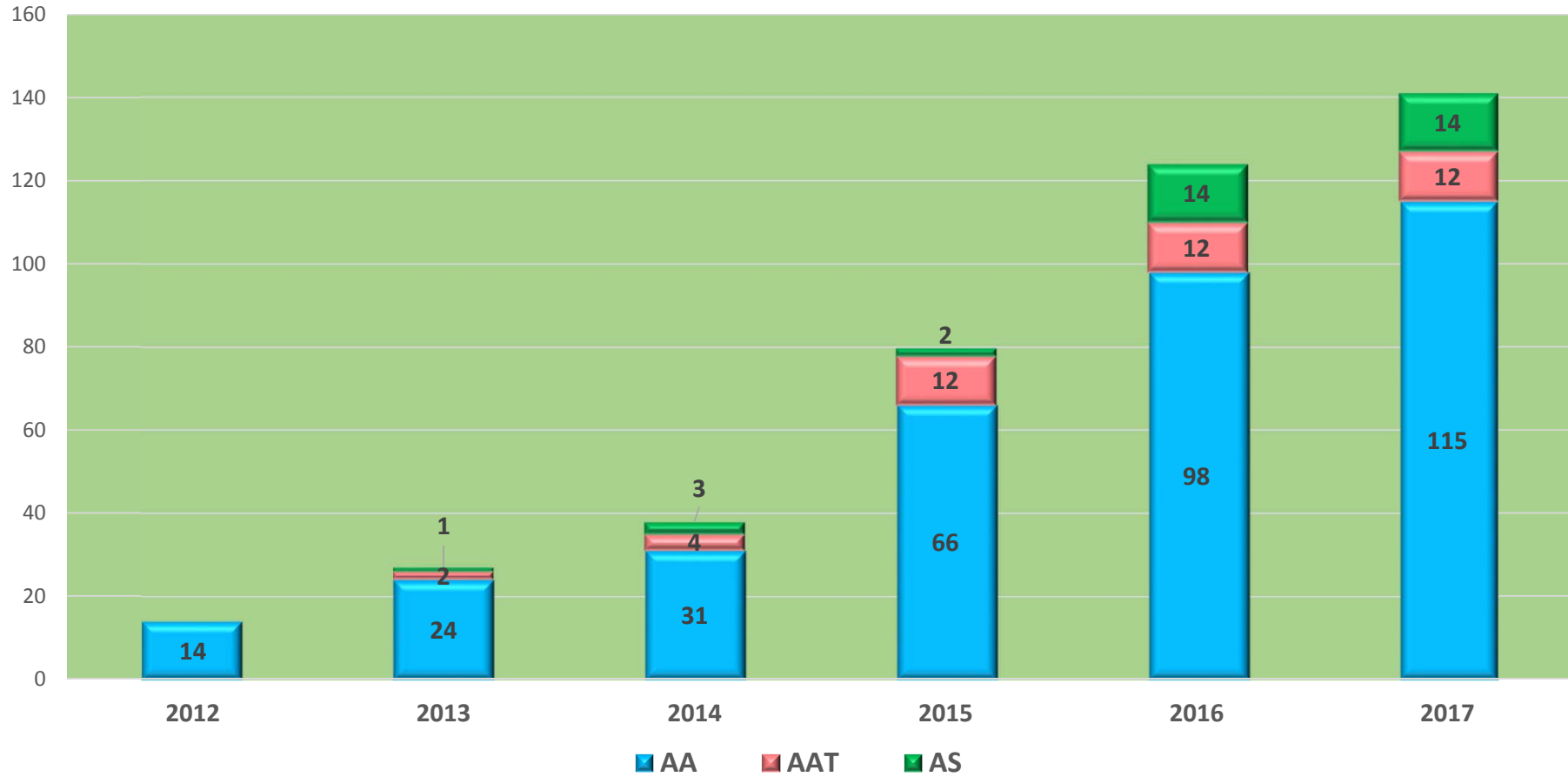


County of FTIC Students at NLC in 2017
