The Logistics Management Department at Palo Alto College and the Port of San Antonio will host Logistics Industry Day on Friday, Oct. 28, from 9 am - 2 pm. The event will be held at the Mabry Center on the Port of San Antonio, 102 Mabry. Admission is free and open to the public.

This event is designed to assist those individuals currently working in the logistics field and also those interested in pursuing a career in logistics. Institutions of higher learning such as Palo Alto College, Texas A&M University - San Antonio, and the University of the Incarnate Word will be available to answer questions about their individual degree programs in logistics. Companies such as Union Pacific, UPS, Goodwill, Hero Logistics, and others will also provide information about logistics positions within their companies and what the educational and training requirements are for those positions.
