- A minimum of 12 completed college level course hours at the Alamo Colleges
- Be in good academic and civic standing with the Alamo Colleges
- Be enrolled at any of the Alamo Colleges and able to serve a term that will begin on May 1st and end on April 30th.
- Have a GPA of at least 2.5

*Also Encouraged:

- Proof of community service hours
- Participated in a Student club or organization

Applying students are to submit a brief essay addressing their interest and credentials for this position.

Students who meet the requirements and submit an essay will then be invited to an interview.

In the interview be ready to discuss:

- Your academic standing
- Your community service hours
- The demographic make-up of all the Alamo Colleges (social, economic, and historical backgrounds) and how they make each student population unique
- Your personal vision for the future of the Alamo Colleges

Every college will nominate a student for the position of Student Trustee who will appear before District Leadership and give a brief presentation addressing why they believe they would be the best candidate for the position.
