

Student Profile Fall 2013


- 25% Full-Time, 75% Part-Time




Course Completion Rates






Productive Grade Rates





Number of High Risk Courses





Fall-to-Fall FTIC Persistence Rates






Four-Year FTIC Graduation Rates






Degrees and Certificates Awarded






6-Year Transfer Rates






Technical Students Employed within Six Months of Graduation

- 4. Reverse Transfer Degrees










Four-Year FTIC Graduation Rates by Ethnicity






Four-Year FTIC Graduation Rates by Gender






Degrees and Certificates Awarded by Ethnicity






Degrees and Certificates Awarded by Gender






Technical Students Employed within Six Months of Graduation by Ethnicity
