RULES FOR USING VISUAL AIDS:

- 1. Avoid using the chalkboard
- 2. Prepare visual aids in advance
- 3. Practice with your visual aids
- 4. Make sure your visual aids are big enough for all to see
- 5. Display visual aids where all listeners can see them
- 6. Do not stand in front of visual aids
- 7. Avoid passing visual aids among the audience (use caution)
- 8. Do not give a handout to your audience while you are speaking
- 9. Display visual aids only while discussing them
- 10. Talk to your audience not your visual aids
- 11. Explain visual aids clearly and concisely
- 12. Use your aid during the speech not after
- 13. Do not put many small photos on one sheet of poster board
