



Admissions Requirements

It is required that all Histologic Technician Program applicants follow the procedures below. Any interested student must first apply for admission to the college and have completed the program prerequisite course and then apply for admission into the program. Unsuccessful completion of all items within the mandated time-frame will preclude the application and therefore the application will not be considered for admission review.

- Meeting criteria for selection does not guarantee admission to the program. Final selection will be based on the applicant pool and space available.
- All applicants must complete all the course prerequisites prior to submitting their applications. For questions or concerns pertaining to the prerequisites, please contact the program director.
- Complete application packets for the program must be mailed and postmarked by USPS **no later than July 15th** for entry in to the Fall semester class (see application checklist for mailing instructions).
- Application packet must include:
 1. Completion of program application with initialed checklist
 2. Completion of the TEAS exam
 3. Submission of all official transcripts from all colleges attended (see application checklist for more information)

By submitting an application packet, an individual verifies that he/she has:

- 1) Read the web page
- 2) Obtained all necessary documents
- 3) Understood the procedures to be followed for admission into the Histologic Technician Program
