

Successes and Areas for Improvement (Challenges)

The items below are areas where San Antonio is either outperforming (Successes) or under performing (Challenges) as compared to all other large colleges who participated in the Spring 2002 field test. CCSSE recommends looking at the items below as starting discussion points. The items that appear under 'Successes' are items where San Antonio's means are significantly higher than all other large colleges, at the .001 level, whereas the items that appear under 'Areas for Improvement' are items where San Antonio's means are significantly lower.
