 - E-1 through E-4, stationed on Lackland AFB
- Student must be in good standing
- Possess minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 or equivalent
- Enrolled in Alamo Colleges courses at Lackland AFB

APPLICATION DEADLINE: August 6, 2010 at 4:00p.m.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Must be a student in good standing
2. Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 or equivalent
3. Active Duty military member stationed on Lackland AFB, must be E-4 or below OR Spouse of Active Duty military member (must be E-4 or below) stationed on Lackland AFB
4. Enrolled in Alamo Colleges courses at Lackland AFB – includes hybrid courses and hybrid internet courses which meet on Lackland AFB

Application Procedures

1. Complete Ike Baxter Airman's Scholarship application
2. Official transcripts from all previous colleges attended must be turned in with application.*
3. Official high school transcripts are required if no prior college coursework exists.*

*Copies of transcripts are acceptable if official transcripts are already on file at the Alamo Colleges.

Awards are based upon below enrollment criteria:

1. Full time enrollment (12 sem. hrs.): 6 semester hours in both flex I and flex II (\$150.00 per flex)
2. Half time enrollment (6 sem. hrs.): 3 semester hours in both flex I and flex II (\$75.00 per flex)
3. Students must be enrolled for both flex sessions at the beginning of the long term to be awarded.
4. Scholarship is awarded in the fall and may be renewed in the spring semester, contingent upon satisfactory academic progress and availability of funds.
5. Awards will not be given for $\frac{1}{4}$ or $\frac{3}{4}$ time enrollment.
6. Students who withdraw from courses may not be eligible for renewal.
