

ORDER CALLING TRUSTEE GENERAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees (the "Board") of the Alamo Colleges ("ACCD" or "District") has the authority to call a general election on May 10, 2014 for trustees to serve six-year terms for single-member districts four (4), eight (8), and nine (9); and,

WHEREAS, multiple entities are holding elections on the same date; and

WHEREAS, the Board has the authority pursuant to Chapter 271 Texas Election Code and Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code, to enter into election agreements with other entities holding elections on the same date; and

WHEREAS, the Board also has the authority pursuant to Chapter 31 Texas Election Code, to enter into a contract for election services with Bexar County; and

WHEREAS, ACCD is authorized to designate polling places for early voting and election day voting for this election;

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE ALAMO COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT THAT:

Section 1. Call of Election; Date; Eligible Electors; and Hours. An election (the "Election") shall be held on Saturday, May 10, 2014, which is seventy-one (71) or more days from the date of the adoption of this order (the "Order") within the territory of ACCD for trustees to serve six-year terms for single member districts four (4), eight (8) and nine (9), at which all resident, qualified electors of ACCD shall be entitled to vote for candidates for the college board trustee position at issue. The Board hereby finds that holding the Election on such date, which is a uniform election date, is in the public interest. The hours during which the polling places are to be open for the Election shall be from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Section 2. Conduct of Election, Election Services Agreements and Appointment of Election Officers. The Election shall be conducted by election officers, in accordance with the Texas Education Code, the Texas Election Code and the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas and the United States of America. An electronic voting system, as defined and described in Title 8 of the Texas Election Code, shall be utilized for the Election.

Pursuant to Chapter 31 of the Texas Election Code, the Board orders that this Election be conducted under the terms and conditions of an Election Services Agreement between Bexar County and Alamo Community College District, which is attached and labeled as Exhibit "A" to this Order and incorporated by reference as if fully set out herein. Under said Agreement, Bexar County will conduct elections for multiple entities including Alamo Community College District.

As authorized by Chapter 31 of the Texas Election Code, the Board appoints

Ms. Jacquelyn Callanen, Bexar County Election Administrator as Election Officer to perform the duties set forth in the Election Services Agreement between Bexar County and Alamo Community College District for conducting the Election in the portion of the District that is located within Bexar County. The Board also appoints Sandra Mora as the Alamo Community College Election Administrator to perform the duties set forth in the Election Services Agreement between Bexar County and Alamo Community College District for conducting the Election.

Chapter 271 of the Texas Election Code provides that the authorities of two or more political subdivisions that have ordered elections for the same day in all or part of the same territory may enter into an agreement to hold the elections jointly in election precincts that can be served by common polling places, and the Board is expressly authorizing this action. This joint election agreement will be approved at a subsequent meeting of the board.

Section 3. Voting Precincts. Except as otherwise provided herein the presently existing boundaries and territory of the respective Bexar County Election Precincts, that are wholly or partially within the territorial boundaries of ACCD, are hereby designated as the voting precincts of ACCD for the Election. The precinct numbers for ACCD's election precincts shall be the corresponding Bexar County Election Precinct Number of each precinct that is wholly or partially within the District.

Section 4. Early Voting Polling Places and Times. The early voting polling places and times for early voting in Bexar County are hereby designated in Exhibit "B" to this Order, which is incorporated herein by reference for all purposes.

Section 5. Polling Places. The election day polling places for the Election for each of the respective precincts in Bexar County are hereby designated in Exhibit "C" to this Order, which is incorporated herein by reference for all purposes. Section 271.003 of the Texas Election Code provides that voters of a particular election precinct or a political subdivision may be served in a joint election by a common polling place located outside the boundary of the election precinct or political subdivision if the location can adequately and conveniently serve the affected voters and will facilitate the orderly conduct of the election. To the extent any polling place utilized by the District and designated in Exhibit "C" for the conduct of the Election is located outside the boundaries of an election precinct, the Board specifically finds that the polling place selected by the District is convenient and will adequately serve the voters of the District.

Section 6. Presiding Judges and Alternates. The Board hereby designates the presiding judges and alternate presiding judges appointed by the Bexar County Election Administrator for the respective election precincts. The presiding judge at each precinct shall have authority to retain and deputize clerks for the conduct of the Election in accordance with the directives established by the Bexar County Elections Administrator for this election.

In the event that Bexar County shall determine from time to time that (a) the polling places hereby established and designated shall become unavailable or unsuitable for such use, or it would be in the District's best interests to relocate the polling places,

or (b) that the Presiding Election Judge, Alternate Presiding Judges appointed or hereinafter designated shall become disqualified or unavailable, the County is hereby authorized to designate and appoint in writing substitute polling places, Presiding Election Judges or Alternate Presiding Election Judges, giving such notice as is required by the Election Code and as deemed sufficient. Furthermore, the County is hereby authorized to allow Presiding Election Judges or Alternate Presiding Election Judges, upon request to designate and appoint such additional clerks as may be required from time to time to assist at polling places in order to efficiently carry out the duties of the office, giving such notice as is required by the Election Code and as deemed sufficient.

Section 7. Election Information to be provided in Spanish. The Custodian of Records appointed by the Board shall be responsible for the preparation of notices, instructions, orders, ballots and other written material pertaining to the Election and shall cause each such document to be translated into and furnished to voters in both the English language and the Spanish language in order to aid and assist voters speaking Spanish as a primary or an alternative language to properly participate in the election process, except as otherwise provided by the Election services Agreement. In addition, the Custodian is hereby authorized and directed to make available to the voters having the need of an individual capable of acting as a translator and speaking both English and Spanish languages who will assist Spanish speaking voters in understanding and participating in the election process.

Section 8. Appointment of Custodian of Records and Agent. To the extent not otherwise provided for in the Election Agreements, the Board appoints Sandra Mora ACCD's Election Administrator, as the Custodian of Records ("Custodian") and agent to the Board Secretary to perform the duties related to the conduct and maintenance of records of the Election as required under the Texas Election Code during the period beginning the fiftieth (50th) day before election day and ending not earlier than the fortieth (40th) day after the day of the Election. In particular, the Custodian shall provide applications for candidates, accept applications from candidates for a place on the ballot, determine the order in which names will appear on the ballot for the trustee positions and accept and maintain records regarding campaign expenditures that may be filed with ACCD.

The Custodian shall maintain an office open for election duties for at least three hours each day, during regular office hours, on regular business days during the period required by law. The Custodian shall post notice of the location and hours of her office as required by the Texas Election Code. The Custodian shall maintain in her office, the documents, records and other items relating to the election and shall be the person designated to receive documents on behalf of ACCD that are required by the Texas Election Code.

The Joint Custodian of Records ("Joint Custodian") when the joint election agreement is adopted, pursuant to Sections 66.048 and 271.010 of the Election Code, shall preserve all voted ballots securely in a locked room in the locked ballot boxes for the period for preservation required by the Election Code.

Section 9. Early Voting by Mail. The Board appoints Ms. Jacquelyn Callanen as ACCD's Joint Early Voting Clerk. Ballot applications and ballots voted by mail shall be addressed to ACCD's Joint Early Voting Clerk at the address indicated immediately below.

The Joint Early Voting Clerk for ACCD shall collect all applications for ballots received at the above address during the period allowed by the Texas Election Code.

Section 10. Early Voting. The presiding judge of the Bexar County early voting ballot board shall count and return early voting ballots in accordance with the Election Code. The presiding judges of the early voting ballot board shall appoint two or more election clerks, and such judge and clerks shall constitute the early voting ballot board and shall perform the duties set forth for such board in the Election Code.

Section 11. Canvassing of Returns, Declaring Results. The Custodian shall make a written return of the Election results to the Board in accordance with the Election Code. The Board shall canvass the returns and declare the results of the Election.

If the Board finds at the time of canvassing the election results, that no candidate for a particular place for trustee has received the votes of a majority of the resident, qualified electors voting at the Election, including those voting early, then a June 14, 2014 run-off election will be ordered by the Board between the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes for the particular place on at a time and under procedures appropriate under the Texas Election Code.

Section 12. Notice of Election. Notice of the Election, stating in substance the contents of this Order, shall be published one time in the English and Spanish languages, in a newspaper published within ACCD's territory at least 10 days and no more than 30 days before the Election and as otherwise may be required by the Texas Election Code. Notice of the Election shall also be posted on the bulletin board used by the Board to post notices of the Board's meetings no later than the 21st day before the Election.

Section 13. Training of Election Officials. Pursuant to the Election Code, a public school of instruction for all election officers shall be held.

Section 14. Authorization to Execute. The President of the Board is authorized to execute and the Secretary of the Board is authorized to attest this Order on behalf of the Board; and the President of the Board is authorized to do all other things legal and necessary in connection with the holding and consummation of the Election.

Section 15. Effective Date. This Order is effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

 § CONTRACT FOR ELECTION SERVICES
COUNTY OF BEXAR §

This Contract is entered into by and between the BEXAR COUNTY ELECTIONS ADMINISTRATOR (“ADMINISTRATOR”) on behalf of Bexar County, a political subdivision of the State of Texas, and the ALAMO COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT (“DISTRICT”)(also, individually, a “Party” or, collectively, the “Parties”), pursuant to Texas Election Code Section 31.092.

RECITALS

DISTRICT, by appropriate action of its governing body acting in accordance with all applicable laws, has called an election to be conducted by Bexar County on Saturday, May 10, 2014 and desires that certain election services be provided by ADMINISTRATOR through her Elections Department.

ADMINISTRATOR has provided cost estimates for election services to be rendered by her office pursuant to the terms of this Contract that are set out on Exhibits “A” and “B,” attached and incorporated into this Contract.

DISTRICT and ADMINISTRATOR want to enter into this Contract setting out the respective responsibilities of the Parties.

Accordingly, the Parties agree as follows:

ARTICLE I
PURPOSE

1.01. The Parties have entered into this Contract for election services described in Article II to be provided to DISTRICT for its election to be held on May 10, 2014.

ARTICLE II
SERVICES

2.01. ADMINISTRATOR agrees to provide to DISTRICT the following general services:

- (A) Procure and distribute election supplies, including, but not limited to, the preparation, printing and distribution of ballots and sample ballots;
- (B) Procure election judges and clerks for early voting and election day voting;
- (C) Procure early voting polling places and election day polling places, as ordered;
- (D) Procure, prepare, and distribute adequate election equipment and transport equipment to and from the initial polling locations, including early voting substations, for DISTRICT;
- (E) Distribute the lists of registered voters to be used in conducting the election, as provided by Bexar County Voter Registration pursuant to the request by DISTRICT;
- (F) Pay election day and early voting judges and clerks;

- (G) Pay the judges for election night returns and early voting returns;
- (H) Provide information for election officers;
- (I) Provide general overall supervision of the election and advisory services;
- (J) Prepare writ of election to election officers and notice of appointment to Presiding and Alternate judges, as required by law;
- (K) Conduct early voting, in person and by mail, for DISTRICT;
- (L) Establish a Central Counting Station for the purpose of tabulating ballots;
- (M) Provide such incidental related services as may be necessary to effect the election;
- (N) Meet ADA requirements as the law relates to polling locations and voter assistance, etc; and
- (O) Provide for Central Count Tabulation (s):
 - a. Preparation and programming of the ballots on the AIS 650 Optical Scanner
 - b. Preparation and tabulation of votes from the iVotronic Voting System.

ARTICLE III
SCHEDULE FOR PERFORMANCE OF SERVICES

3.01. Specific services to be provided related to the general services identified in Article II will be performed in accordance with the time requirements set out in the Texas Election Code.

ARTICLE IV
SERVICES NOT PROVIDED BY COUNTY

4.01. ADMINISTRATOR shall have no responsibility for insuring the passage of the appropriate Election Order by the DISTRICT, publishing and (or) posting the election notice as required by the Texas Election Code Section 4.003, or canvassing election results. ADMINISTRATOR shall have no responsibility as custodian of DISTRICT'S election records.

ARTICLE V
TERM

5.01. Except as hereinafter set out, the term of this Contract will be from the time of execution until all items with respect to this Contract and the election held hereunder have been completed.

ARTICLE VI
COST OF SERVICE AND BILLING

6.01. In consideration for the services provided hereunder by ADMINISTRATOR, DISTRICT shall pay ADMINISTRATOR the actual cost of performing the services, including any overtime incurred by ADMINISTRATOR'S employees. DISTRICT shall deposit with ADMINISTRATOR _____ no later than April 4, 2014 to cover the estimated pro rata cost.

6.02. If the actual election costs exceed DISTRICT'S deposit, the difference between the actual costs and the deposit will be paid by DISTRICT within 30 days after receiving an itemized invoice from ADMINISTRATOR. Payment must be made by check payable to the Bexar County Clerk and mailed to:

6.03. Any monies remaining after the payment of all costs of elections bills, will be the property of the DISTRICT and returned to it.

ARTICLE VII
GENERAL PROVISIONS

7.01. This Contract will be construed under and in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, and all obligations of the Parties created hereunder are performable in Bexar County, Texas.

7.02. If any one or more of the provisions contained in this Contract is for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, that invalidity, illegality or unenforceability will not affect any other provision, and this Contract will be construed as if the invalid, illegal or unenforceable provision had never been contained in the Contract.

7.03. This Contract constitutes the sole and only agreement of the Parties and supersedes any prior understanding or written or oral agreement between the Parties respecting the written subject matter.

7.04. No amendment, modification, or alteration of this Contract will be binding unless it is in writing, dated subsequent to the date hereof and executed by the Parties.

ARTICLE VIII
BACKGROUND CHECKS

8.01 ADMINISTRATOR has conducted all criminal background checks required by Texas Election Code § 129.051(g).
