Summer Camp Behavior Agreement

In order for your child to participate in the Palo Alto College summer camps, please review and agree to the following behavior guidelines.

1. Students will show complete respect and courtesy to all instructors, personnel, and peers.
2. Students will follow instructions and participate fully in camp activities.
3. Students will act calmly and speak quietly while passing through campus buildings.
4. Students will follow instructor guidelines about when and where food is allowed.
5. Students will follow instructor guidelines about using electronic devices during class.
6. All personal belongings should be labeled with the student's name. Palo Alto College is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or misplaced items.
7. No drugs or medications are allowed on campus. All prescription medications should be administered by parents or legal guardians and be reported in the registration process.

If the student does not follow this behavior agreement or demonstrates otherwise disruptive behavior, the following actions will be taken:

First warning: The student will receive verbal counseling explaining the issue and instructing them to discontinue the behavior.

Second warning: The student's parents/legal guardians will be contacted.

Third warning: The student will be withdrawn from the camp with no refund.
