



## Rules for Youth Visiting the Library

Parents/care givers should feel free to bring their children to our facilities. The following rules are in place for the safety and welfare of children, ensuring a quiet environment conducive to academic study.

### **Supervision**

All youth under 18 years of age must be either accompanied by a responsible adult or be registered in a college program. Youth will remain within sight of the accompanying adult at all times in the facility. Youth will be asked to leave if they are causing a disturbance to other users. There must be an adult with them to be responsible for their safety and welfare.

### **Computers**

All computers are available only for research and educational purposes. Youth under 18 years of age are allowed to use the computers for these purposes if they are accompanied by a responsible adult or registered in a college program.

### **Law Enforcement Action**

It may be necessary to notify appropriate law enforcement or child protective authorities if youth:

- are being repeatedly disruptive;
- are left unattended for a long period of time;
- are deemed to be at risk of harm (as in the case of being left alone when the library closes)
