

Andrew Scott – Moderator; Artist/Professor at University of Texas at Dallas

Biography: Artist and professor, Andrew Scott works at the intersection of digital fabrication technologies, traditional fine arts practices and collective cultural ideals. Utilizing laser cutters, CNC mills, 3D printers and scanning technologies, he fabricates sculptures, creates installations and immersive visual experiences by using projection mapping to bring static objects to life. His creative practice spans more than three decades. Scott is an Associate Professor of Art and Technology at the University of Texas at Dallas. Born in Brooklyn, New York, he holds a B.F.A. from Long Island University, Southampton and an M.F.A. from The Ohio State University, he has also studied at its Advanced Computing Center for the Arts and Design (ACCAD).
