The second digit indicates the number of semester hours the course is worth, and the last two digits identify the course sequence.

ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE STANDARDS

Students must maintain a 2.00 cumulative grade point average to maintain good academic standing. Students failing to meet the minimum standards are placed on "Scholastic Probation." Failure to meet the minimum standards in the subsequent semester/term, result in "Enforced Scholastic Withdrawal."

ACADEMIC STANDING

Effective Fall 1991 academic standards were revised. Scholastic Probation and Enforced Scholastic Withdrawal status prior to Fall 1991 are not applicable.

CONTINUING EDUCATION UNITS

The Continuing Education Unit (CEU) is a national unit of measurements for non-credit Education courses. One CEU is equal to 10 clock hours of instruction. CEU's are only awarded for Adult Vocational Courses and are based on the total course hours or the actual hours attended, depending on the course at the time of its approval by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board.
