
SPC student enrollment has increased 65.3% since Fall 2021.




Over the years, approximately 86% of students have been part-time.




Note: SPC did not offer Face-to Face courses in Fall 2021 due to COVID.


While SPC enrolls more females, the college graduates more male students.





### Enrollment Trends by Age




### Enrollment Trends by Student Status
