KNOW YOUR IX

Title IX is a federal law that prohibits discrimination of sex (gender), sexual orientation, & gender identity

Schools can not discourage you from continuing your education or removal from class.

The Student Conduct & Title
IX Office facilitates
accommodations for
pregnant students and
associated conditions.

SAC employees & staff are required to report instances of Title IX that involve students

Title IX applies to all students regardless of gender identity.

Schools may not retaliate against someone filing a complaint and must ensure all parties are safe from retaliatory and/or harassing behavior.

Title IX protects
transgender and gender
non-conforming students
from gender-based
harassment and bullying.

Schools must publish their Title IX polices and procedures for all students, faculty & staff

Schools can initiate supportive measures. Whiich can include issuing a No Contact directive to prevent contact between the involved parties
