Upon successful completion, graduates of the Respiratory Care Technology Program at St. Philip's College receive an Associates of Applied Science degree and are eligible to apply for the National Board for Respiratory Care (NBRC) Therapist Multiple Choice Exam and the NBRC Clinical Simulation Exam. Successful completion of the NBRC Therapist Multiple Choice Exam entitles the graduate the Certified Respiratory Therapist credential. Successful completion of both exams entitles the graduate the credential of Registered Respiratory Therapist (RRT).

In addition to the national CRT & RRT credentials, there is credentialing at the state level through the Texas Medical Board. Practitioners must apply for the state credential of Respiratory Care Practitioner (RCP). You may contact the Texas Medical Board at (512) 305-7010.
