

Fall 2010 Tutoring Reports

St. Philip's College Fall 2010 Tutoring Versus Non-Tutoring Student GPA

A recent report on Fall 2010 Tutoring Students indicates that the more often a student visits campus tutoring services the higher their GPA is. The average GPA of students with no visits to the tutoring labs in Fall 2010 was 2.6, at 2 to 6 visits the average GPA increased by 14 points. The average GPA of students who attended 7 or more tutoring sessions during the Fall 2010 was 2.87.
