


Figure 46-1 Productive Grade Rate by student demographic groups—ethnicity Data Source: Institutional Research and Effectiveness Service (IRES)





Figure 46-2 Productive Grade Rate by student demographic groups—gender, veteran, total Data Source: Institutional Research and Effectiveness Service (IRES)

Course Completion & Fall to Fall Persistence



Seen in *Figures 46-3* (left) and *46-4* (below), SPC students exhibit high course completion rates of at least 85% across all featured demographics, leading to overall completion rates in the 93% range across the four academic terms included (fall terms 2016—2019).

Figure 46-5 (below) displays fall to fall persistence across selected demographics groups (gender, veteran, and ethnicity) from fall 2015-2016; 2016-2017; 2017-2018. Although the total persistence rates remain in the 45-48% range, for fall 2018-2019, full time, first time in college (FTIC) students achieved a persistence rate of 62.7% (not shown, data source: Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board).




Figure 46-4 Course completion by gender and veteran status, total Data Source: Institutional Research and Effectiveness Service (IRES)




Figure 46-5 Fall to fall FTIC persistence by student demographics: Gender, Veteran Status, and Ethnicity Data Source: Institutional Research and Effectiveness Service (IRES)
