ACADEMIC REMINDER: MIDTERM GRADES COMING UP

Be sure to check your [MIDTERM GRADES](#) for your course(s) with Northwest Vista College (NVC) by logging into the [ACES portal](#) or the [Alamo Colleges Mobile App](#). Midterm grades are a great way to see how you're doing and make sure you're staying on track academically.

- Year-long Courses: January 12th (now available)
- Spring Courses: Midterm grades available after March 30th

Remember, these grades are only for progress monitoring and will not appear on your official transcript with Alamo Colleges. If you have questions or concerns about your grade, now is the perfect time to reach out to your instructor.

How to Check Midterm Grades at NVC:

- [ACES Portal](#): Log into ACES, navigate to the "Student" tab, and look for midterm grade reports.
- [Alamo Mobile App](#): Use your ACES credentials to log in and check grades for current classes.

NEW APPLICATION FOR DC STUDENTS FOR FALL 2026 TERM

For the FALL 2026 term, the Alamo Colleges Dual Credit Program allows eligible students to earn high school and college credit at the same time. Your school must offer dual credit (or you must verify home school status). Choose courses that fit your college or career goals - reach out for more information.
