Accreditation Update January 2017

San Antonio College was placed on a 12-month warning by its accrediting body, Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) in December 2016.

SAC remains accredited.

The College will address the following standards in a formal report before the September 8, 2017 deadline.

 (Policy compliance: "Reaffirmation of Accreditation and Subsequent Reports")
- Federal Requirement 4.7
 (Title IV program responsibilities)
