Applications are being accepted for the T-STEM Challenge Scholarships of up to \$2,500 for Fall, Spring and Summer.

2018 -2019 Alamo Colleges students with a declared major in a STEM (science, technology, engineering or mathematics) programs, including specific Allied Health majors are eligible to apply. You must have a 3.0 in your high school math and science courses (or GED) and a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher on your current college transcript to be eligible.

To apply:

- Submit a scholarship application with your official high school transcript to your T-STEM liaison.
- Agree to complete 30 hours before the end of summer 2019
- Complete 80% of coursework per semester
- Limit the number of hours worked in an internship, clinical rotations or employment with a T-STEM Business/industry partner to no more than an average of 15 hours per week during the semester
- Register for the Selective Services System if you are a male between the ages of 18 and 25: <https://www.sss.gov/RegVer/wfRegistration.aspx>
