It is recommended that students take both career assessments, offered by Northeast Lakeview College, the Focus 2 and the Career Coach.


Instructions for the Focus 2:

2) Scroll down to about the middle of the webpage and expand the “**Explore Careers**” toolbar.


3) To launch the Focus 2, click the link to “**Create your profile.**”


