The Springboard Foundation is proud to extend scholarships to full-time undergraduate college/university students who have documented disabilities of any type that are protected under the Americans with Disabilities Act and/or the Rehabilitation Act of 1973. Our scholarship recipients attend college and universities across the United States and are currently registered with their Colleges/Universities disability services office.

2021 The Springboard Foundation Scholarship Application Informational Page:

GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY:

- Students must have completed 24 credits at an accredited College or University.
- Students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Students must be registered with their colleges/universities disability services office. Students must provide a letter from the disability services office confirming registration with the office.
- U.S. CITIZENS and U.S. PERMANENT RESIDENTS ONLY are eligible to apply.

REQUIRED SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION DOCUMENTS:

- Applicants must provide a letter from the disability services office confirming registration with the office.

- Applicants must provide two recommendation letters, please inform the individual that they will receive an email from The Springboard Foundation with instructions to upload the recommendation letter.
- Applicants are requested to provide two photos; a headshot photo and a photo of the student around campus.
- Applicants must provide an official transcript.
- Applicants must provide proof of registration for the next term or session.
- Applicants are required to answer a short essay prompt and provide details about their co-curricular activities
- **Now accepting video essay submissions! Applicants may either upload a 2-5-minute video file or a document with 300-400 words answering the personal essay question.**

Our Timeline

- March 15: The online scholarship application opens, and students can apply.
- June 15: The online scholarship application closes.
- June-August: Scholarship recipients are selected. Only fully completed applications are reviewed.
- Late August: Applicants are notified if they did or did not receive a scholarship.
- Summer/September: Recipients must return forms necessary to receive their scholarships. The Springboard Foundation sends scholarship funds directly to students.
- Please note that students do not apply to a specific scholarship(s). Students complete one online application through our website and we match them to all scholarships for which they meet the eligibility.
- **Please note, for courses completed during the Spring/Fall 2020 or Spring 2021 terms with a pass/fail grade this will not impact student eligibility for scholarships.**
