

TAKE THE FIRST STEP TOWARD ALAMOPROMISE

The AlamoPROMISE program makes college more accessible to graduating seniors by providing the support necessary to earn a certificate or associate degree at one of the five Alamo Colleges.

It ensures that tuition and fees at the Alamo Colleges are covered for students who graduate from participating high schools. Through AlamoPROMISE, scholars who meet the eligibility criteria will receive a “last-dollar” scholarship for up to three years or the completion of an associate’s degree or certificate, whichever comes first. The “last-dollar” scholarship funds the cost of tuition and required fees that your financial aid award does not cover. Your household income does not disqualify you and there is no minimum academic requirement for admission. Because we understand plans sometimes change, you are not locked into a commitment when you pledge to Save Your Seat.



ALAMOPROMISE HIGH SCHOOLS

To become an AlamoPROMISE scholar, you must be a senior from a participating high school graduating during the 2020-2021 academic school year and a Bexar County resident.

AlamoPROMISE ELIGIBILITY STEPS



STEP 1: Start By Saving Your Seat

By February 15, 2021: submit a Save Your Seat form online at alamo.edu/promise or by scanning our QR code.



STEP 2: Apply To An Alamo Colleges District College

By February 15, 2021: submit your application for admission through ApplyTexas to any of our five colleges in the Alamo Colleges District. Visit applytexas.org.



STEP 3: File for Financial Aid

By March 15, 2021: submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA). Visit fafsa.gov or access the TASFA at alamo.edu/admission--aid/paying-for-college. Make sure to submit any required documents needed to complete your financial aid award.
