Saint Philip's College plans to close the Canyon Lake High School off-campus instructional site. The site is being closed because Canyon Lake HS phased out dual enrollment students from St. Philip's College and is moving them to Northeast Lakeview College.

No students were enrolled in the program in the fall of 2021. Students were informed of the closure as soon as the switch to the other college was finalized. Students will continue taking courses at the other institution. Students will not incur any additional charges because of the site closure. No faculty or staff will be affected by the site closure. Adjunct faculty will apply to teach at the other college.

The Board of Trustees of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges approves the closure of the Canyon Lake High School off-campus instructional site (OCIS).
