Palo Alto College to host drive-through holiday display with virtual lighting

Palo Alto College invites the community to celebrate with them at Winter Wonderland ¡Celebración!, which will join together Palo Alto College's annual holiday light display with our annual scholarship and program fundraiser.

The month-long event will kick off with a virtual holiday lighting on Thursday, Dec. 3 at 6:30 p.m. that will be livestreamed on the College's <u>Facebook</u> and <u>YouTube</u> channels. The livestream will be viewable to the public and will feature holiday fun and several celebrity guests.

The drive through light display will be open for community members on weekends (Friday–Sunday) from Friday, Dec. 4 through Sunday, Jan. 3 from 6–9 p.m. Visitors will enjoy nearly a million lights in 500 light displays along a quarter mile drive through the Palo Alto College Campus. All cars will enter campus from Villaret Blvd. and exit at 410 near the Performing Arts Center. This year's event is drive-through only; all guests must remain in their vehicle.
