






#### Course Completion Rates






## **Productive Grade Rates**







## Fall 16-to-Fall 17 Full-time FTIC Comparative Persistence Rates










#### Four-Year FTIC Graduation Rates






#### Degrees and Certificates Awarded






#### Degrees & Certificates Awarded by Ethnicity






#### Degrees & Certificates Awarded by Gender







## 6-Year FTIC Transfer Rates




