## C.2.2.2 (Procedure) Traffic and Parking Controls

The operation of a motor vehicle or bicycle on the property of the College District is a privilege granted by the College District and is not an inherent right of any employee or student. All employees who operate vehicles or who park on the property of the College District shall purchase a vehicle registration permit. Purchase of a vehicle registration permit does not guarantee a place to park on campus.

State laws and College District rules and regulations pertaining to the operation and parking of vehicles on College District property shall be followed at all times by all parties who operate or park vehicles on College District property.
