


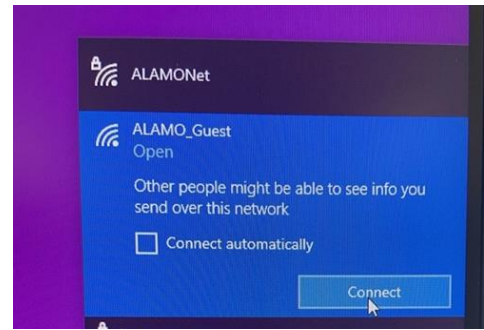


Connecting your Windows 11 Device to a Wireless Network
