

# Institutional Student Learning Outcomes (ISLO) Assessment

- Required for all core education courses based on the list from the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB)
- Cycle I: Critical Thinking and Communication
  - i. Ensure students complete the ISLO assignment and submit through Canvas
  - ii. December 1-13, 2025
    - Faculty verify Canvas ISLO assignment is linked to RCampus
    - IPRE runs random stratified sampling of Fall core courses; Faculty and department chairs are **not** notified which courses are selected for sampling.
    - IPRE imports student artifacts into RCampus from the sampled courses.

# Data Requests


- <u>Request Form</u> (formally compels IPRE to begin preparing, aggregating/segregating, and validating requested data sets)
  - Be as detailed in your request as possible; consider the following
    - i. Ensure you know what data you're requesting
    - ii. Why do you need this data

In 2026, IPRE will launch a "Data Dashboard" which will feature customizable data points allowing users to query and download their own reports with data relevant to their needs and area.
