



NEW CHAPTER, NEW CAMPUS: HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS HEADING TO COLLEGE



As high school seniors prepare for their first year in college, such as Alamo Colleges, including Northwest Vista College (NVC), they are completing key steps like ApplyTexas, ordering dual credit transcripts, submitting high school transcripts, attending college orientation, and meeting with academic advisors to register for academic courses. These milestones will help students transition smoothly into college and start building their academic and career goals. Eligible Bexar County seniors may also benefit from enrolling in AlamoPROMISE, which covers up to three years of tuition and fees for an associate degree through financial aid, grants, and scholarships starting in the Fall 2026 semester.

Steps to Prep for College:

- Complete the [ApplyTexas application](#) for admission to Alamo College (Northwest Vista College) for Fall 2026
- Complete [FAFSA application](#) for Fall 2026
 - Financial Aid Saturdays @NVC from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
- Save your seat with [Alamo Promise Scholarship](#)
- Submit College Transcript
 - If you took OnRamps, UTSA, or College Board AP scores
 - If attending another institution other than Alamo Colleges
 - Spring term grades available by mid-June
 - CTE courses request transcript from participating college
- Complete Bacterial meningitis requirements
- Meet with your Academic Advisor and/or Enrollment Coach
 - Degree Planning
 - Course selections

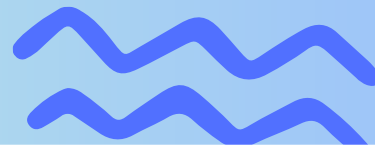

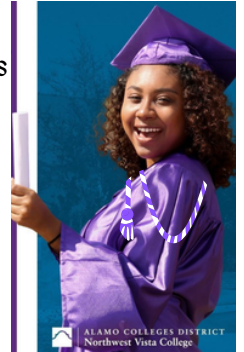
DUAL CREDIT GRADUATION CORDS: FOR SENIORS 2026!
