a. Standardized Entrance Exam - ATI TEAS score - Must be one year current to deadline date of application period.
b. At least 1 point in each category (Reading, Math, Science \& Language usage) must be achieved.
c. Minimum of 4 points must be achieved in order to be considered for admission.
