- 7. NSO/Advising: FTIC/Dual Credit students must attend New Student Orientation (NSO) and Advising. Students transferring or returning to Palo Alto College from a previous college or university and former Palo Alto College students who have not attended for more than one year will need to attend an Advising sessions.
