Preparing for final exams and planning your next set of courses are key steps to staying on track in your dual credit journey. Use the tips below to finish the semester strong and make informed decisions for the upcoming academic year.

- Start preparing early by creating a study schedule and breaking material into manageable chunks
- Review notes, assignments, and key concepts from the entire semester
- Use tutoring and academic support resources when needed
- Ask your instructors for help or clarification on difficult topics
- Form small study groups to reinforce understanding
- Begin planning for the upcoming academic year ahead of time
- Meet with a dual credit advisor to select courses aligned with your college and career goals
- Balance challenging courses with those that match your strengths
- Check course prerequisites with Dual Credit liaison, counselors, or Dual Credit office to stay on track for graduation

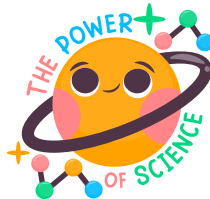
