



Diagnostic Medical Sonography Program

The **Diagnostic Medical Sonography** program is currently accepting applications for the Fall 2020 cohort. The application deadline has been postponed to June 10th, 2020. The program start date, and the number of students accepted, however, is contingent upon Covid-19 development.

The following changes have been made to the 2020 application process:

- Application deadline: postponed to June 10th, 2020.
- Information sessions: canceled, the mandatory information session requirement is waived.
- TEAS test: requirement is waived.
- Volunteering: requirement is waived.

Fall 2020 cohort selection will be based on the following Academic Prerequisites

- Overall GPA of 2.8 or higher
- College Algebra (MATH 1314)
- Introductory Physics (PHYS 1305)
- Human Anatomy and Physiology (BIOL 2101& 2102 or 2404. Courses must include lab)

(All prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of "C" (2.0) or greater within the past 5 years)

Interview:

Panel interview will be conducted via Zoom (cloud based platform for video/audio conferencing). Applicants selected for the interview will be notified via St. Philips College email (student.alamo.edu) about dates/times.
