Notification of offering 25-49% of credit at the off-campus instructional site (OCIS) was accepted in a SACSCOC letter dated August 13, 2018. The institution was notified by the OCIS via email that no students had enrolled in dual-credit courses fall 2020. In a subsequent phone call (May 4, 2021), the institution was informed the high school closed December 31, 2020. Plans to develop a charter school are ongoing.

Students and parents were informed by the Agape Christian Academy administration via letters and a parent meeting. As Agape Christian Academy has ceased operations, students have transferred to other area high schools and are offered dual-credit opportunities at other high school locations.

All instructors remain St. Philip's College online-approved instructors and are still employed by the College; consequently, there is no negative impact on faculty due to the closure. The school staff at Agape Christian Academy are still employed by the church at the location.
