


SPC Spring 2013 Veteran Status Profile

The Veterans Affairs Office will assist students who receive benefits under the Veterans Educational Assistance Program (VEAP). The Vetran Affairs staff will assist students by providing certification of courses transmitting such information to the Department of Veteran Affairs. Assistant includes but is not limited to the following: Army Tuition Assistance, Work Study, GI Bill benefits, and the Hazelwood Act Exemption. There were 789 total Veteran Students registered for the Spring 2013 semester of which 321 were Hispanic, 211 were White and 200 were Black African American.

41% of Veteran Students are Hispanic followed by 28% White and 11% Black African American.

Note: A Veteran is defined as students who registered with a status of RC for one or more classes, i.e. used veteran benefits to pay for classes. Flex II students are not included due to census date.
