


Finding Your Financial Aid Requirements on ACES

Option #1: Simplified Navigation (View Requirement Flags & Links)


1. Log into ACES at <https://aces.alamo.edu> using your Username and Password:

 - A red flag means the requirement is incomplete.
 - You can view previous and upcoming aid years by selecting the drop-down menu 'Choose Another Aid Year'



1. Log into ACES at <https://aces.alamo.edu> using your Username and Password:



You must complete this form online or obtain it at your college to allow state aid to pay out to your account. After submission, please allow up to 6 weeks for your form to be processed. <p>Terms and Conditions</p> <p>You must read and accept the student financial aid Terms and Conditions in order to understand your responsibilities as a financial aid recipient.
