



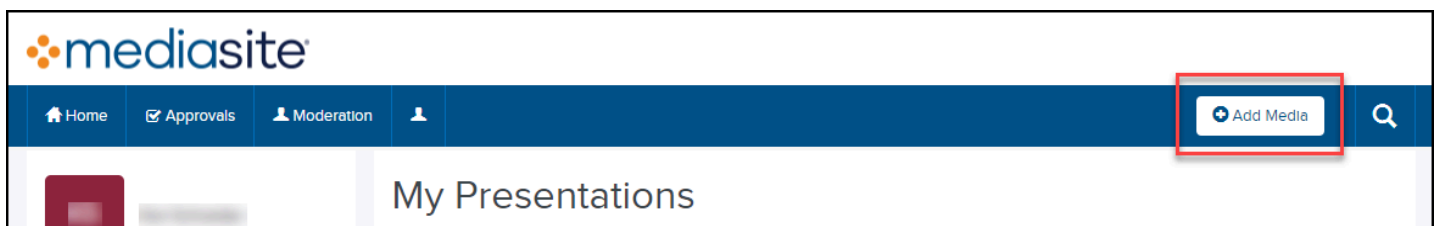
Downloading Mediasite Desktop Recorder



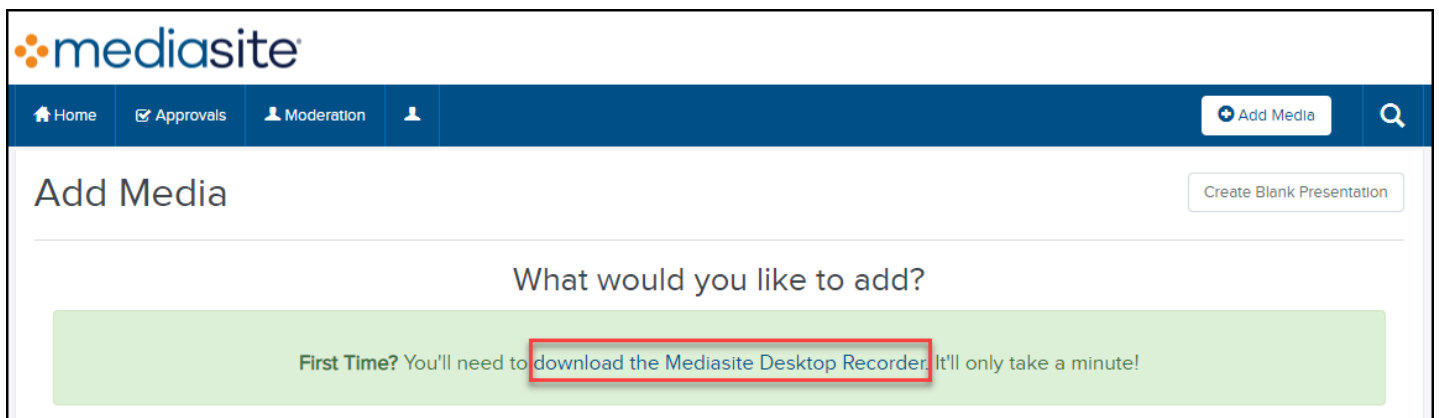
Mediasite has its own recorder that can live on your computer (desktop or laptop). The Desktop Recorder allows you to record with options of screen recording, webcam, and audio or offline without an Internet connection.

1. Click on **Download for Windows** (approximately 50 MB).

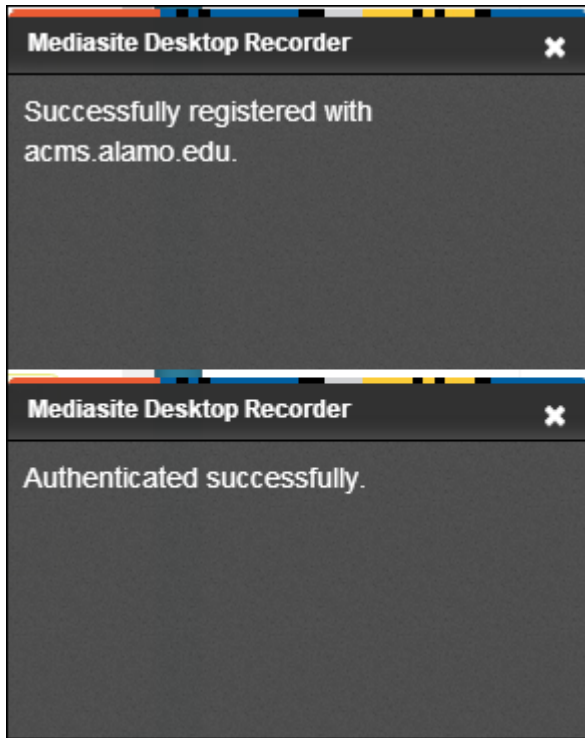
