## **Enrollment Checklist: College Transfer and Transient Students**

Complete Your Admission Application at ApplyTexas.org www.applytexas.org  On the application to two-year schools, select Northeast Lakeview College. Be certain to provide a personal email, not a high school email address. If you are planning to use FAFSA, be sure to provide social security number or residency card information in your application. Allow 5 business days for processing. Once your application has processed, you will receive two emails – a confirmation email from the ApplyTexas and an Alamo College email with instructions on accessing your student portal called ACES.
Submit Official College Transcripts Most recent; send immediately after term completes to begin next term at NLC. Official documents should be submitted to the Admissions and Records office of Northeast Lakeview College. (The checklist on the ACEs home page is for Early College High School students, not typical high school graduates). After you activate your NAVIGATE checklist, click on your Go FAARR and Test Prep Modules. Click the "Enroll" and then the "incomplete" link to view and complete the modules.  Upload Bacterial Meningitis Documentation (Students under 22) STEPS: Login to ACES, Student Tab, Web Services (in Student Self-Service box), Student, Student Records, Bacterial Meningitis. Choose one of the 3 options and submit. Please allow 24-48 hours for processing.
Take the TSI College Readiness Test, If Applicable <a href="https://www.alamo.edu/nlc/admissionsaid/assessment-center/">https://www.alamo.edu/nlc/admissionsaid/assessment-center/</a> If college transcript shows freshman English and Math have passing scores, then no testing is needed. Take a refresher course in English and/or Math, if required Students who do not place college level will be required to take a refresher course before registering for classes. Refresher courses save time, money, and offer the opportunity to move into a higher-level developmental or a college-level course in English or Math. Refresher courses are free.
Register for Classes by Attending Transfer/Returning Student Orientation Transfer/Returning Student Orientation: College transfer and/or returning students with 13-45 college credit hours must sign up for the Transfer/Returning Orientation. If you are transferring in on Academic Probation, you will need to attend ASO (scroll down further on previous link).
