SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES IN THE NATURAL SCIENCES, MATHEMATICS, AND ENGINEERING

The Goldwater Scholarship supports outstanding students interested in research careers in the natural sciences, mathematics, and engineering. The scholarship covers undergraduate eligible expenses for tuition, fees, books, and room and board up to \$7,500 per academic year for up to 2 years.

ELIGIBILITY

To be considered for nomination, a student must:

- Have a minimum of one semester and no more than two years of undergraduate study remaining beginning September 2023.
- Be pursuing a bachelor's degree on a full-time basis.
- Have an average GPA > 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
- Have a demonstrated interest in a research career in the natural sciences, mathematics, or engineering.
- Be nominated by his or her college or university via the official online nomination application.

HOW TO APPLY

NOMINATION PERIOD

First Tuesday in September through 5:00 p.m., CT on the last Friday in January.

Internal campus deadlines will be 5:00 pm on second Friday in January. Contact your Goldwater Campus Representative as early as possible.

To be considered for a nomination for a Goldwater Scholarship by your academic institution, you must first complete and submit a short Student Profile (Name, email address, telephone number, etc.) and Pre-application (Year in school, major, GPA, brief career interest statement, highest degree anticipated, and potential recommendation letter writers) that will help your campus' Goldwater Representative make an initial determination of the strength of your application.
