Facility:

- Eight lane, 25-yard competition course
- Water depth: The minimum water depth, measured in accordance with Article 103.2.3, is seven feet at the start end and the turn end is 18 feet measured for a distance of one meter to five meters from both end walls.
- The racing course has not been certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C(4)
- DAKTRONICS starting and timing systems
- Scoreboard with full heat and event display
- Six constantly available warm-up / cool-down lanes
- Adequate free parking adjacent to the pool
- On-deck stadium seating for 1600
- Concessions and swim shop in the lobby
- Food from outside sources is not permitted in the Aquatic Center
- Chairs are not permitted in the facility
- Deck changing is prohibited!

Rules: •The 2019 – 2020 National Federation Swimming and Diving Rules will govern this meet

Natatorium

Rules:

- All swimmers are required to wear their approved uniforms and warm-ups
- Hats, body or face painting, costumes, and / or props will not be allowed
- Organized cheers by school’s teams will be allowed on deck in front of the designated seating area for each school
- All spirit groups and Team Mascots must stay in the spectator area and will not be allowed on deck
- Athletes and / or teams that violate these rules will be subject to disciplinary actions that could include disqualification from the competition.

Cell phone

Restrictions:

- The presence and / or use of cell phones, and / or any other equipment capable of producing audio recordings, photographic or video images in locker rooms, rest rooms, changing areas or anywhere behind the starting blocks is strictly and specifically prohibited at all times
- There are no exceptions to this prohibition
- Violators are subject to disqualification from the meet, disbarment from the facility and arrest

**Swimmer
Photographs
And Videos:**

- There may be one or more photographers and / or videographers on deck at this meet.
- In the event such personnel are present, parents or guardians of swimmers under the age of 18 who do not wish to have photos or videos of their athletes made, are required to contact the Meet Director prior to the beginning of warm-ups.
- Photographers and videographers are strongly encouraged to stay out of the area immediately behind the starting blocks, but if present, are specifically prohibited from making shots during the start phase of any race.

Format:

- Timed finals
- Fly-over starts employed for all events OTHER than Backstroke.
- No breaks will be taken at any point in the meet
- NO diving
- NO Relays
- NOT Scored
- The Federation Whistle Start and No Recall False Start Procedures will be in use at this meet

- Entry Restrictions:** •Swimmers may enter no more than four (4) events
- Entry fees:** •\$6.00 per individual event
- Entry Deadline:** •1200, Tuesday, September 24, 2019 (No exceptions!)
•No late and / or deck entries will be permitted
- Entry Procedures**
- Entries may be submitted ONLY by Hy-Tek Commlink file
 - Hard copy must accompany
 - Each entry must include the swimmer's full name, swimmers school affiliation grade, and a seedtime
 - Entries received without a seedtime will be rejected
