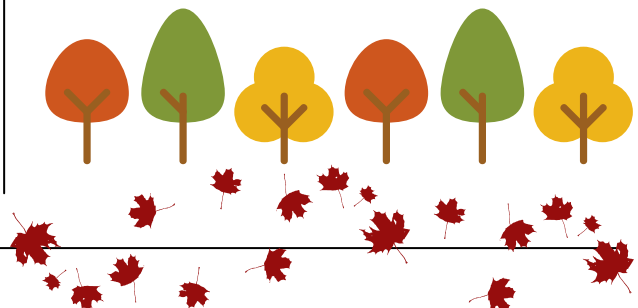

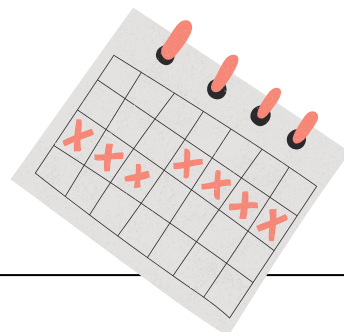
Canvas Studio
