



9 Things to Know about Title IX

KNOW YOUR IX

1

Title IX is a federal law that prohibits discrimination of sex (gender), sexual orientation, & gender identity

Schools may not retaliate against someone filing a complaint and must ensure all parties are safe from retaliatory and/or harassing behavior.

Schools can not discourage you from continuing your education or removal from class.

Title IX protects transgender and gender non-conforming students from gender-based harassment and bullying.

The Student Conduct & Title IX Office facilitates accommodations for pregnant students and associated conditions.

Schools must publish their Title IX policies and procedures for all students, faculty & staff

SAC employees & staff are required to report instances of Title IX that involve students

Schools can initiate supportive measures. Which can include issuing a No Contact directive to prevent contact between the involved parties

Title IX applies to all students regardless of gender identity.
