TEXAS AWARD FOR PERFORMANCE EXCELLENCE

- Site Visit: January 22 - 26, 2018 (On site 8 a.m. - 5 p.m.)
Eight examiners - experts in the Baldrige Criteria for Performance Excellence from around the state
 - Team leader, Examiner for each criteria (6), Process coach.
 - Team lead will contact SPC two weeks prior with interview schedule and requested interviewees.
 - Examiners will conduct "walk-about;" This is an opportunity for them to meet frontline staff. Be yourself. Answer any questions asked. Provide an example if possible.
 - **Note:** If you cannot answer a question say so and refer them to the Tri-Directors.
 - If an examiner asks you for documentation, collect it as quickly as possible, deliver it to the CLR third floor circulation desk.

TAPE SITE VISIT

- What will examiners want to know from you?
 - How does your work contribute to the mission of St. Philip's College?
 - Who is the "customer" of your work?
 - How do you know if you are meeting your customers' requirements? What do you measure on a regular basis?
 - What are some key processes for your area that you are engaged in? How do you improve these?
- Be Prepared
 - Wear name tags and SPC shirts.
 - Review the SPC Institutional Effectiveness--TAPE Employee Engagement Activity in Alamo Talent.
 - Review TAPE application (<http://www.alamo.edu/spc/TAPE/>).
