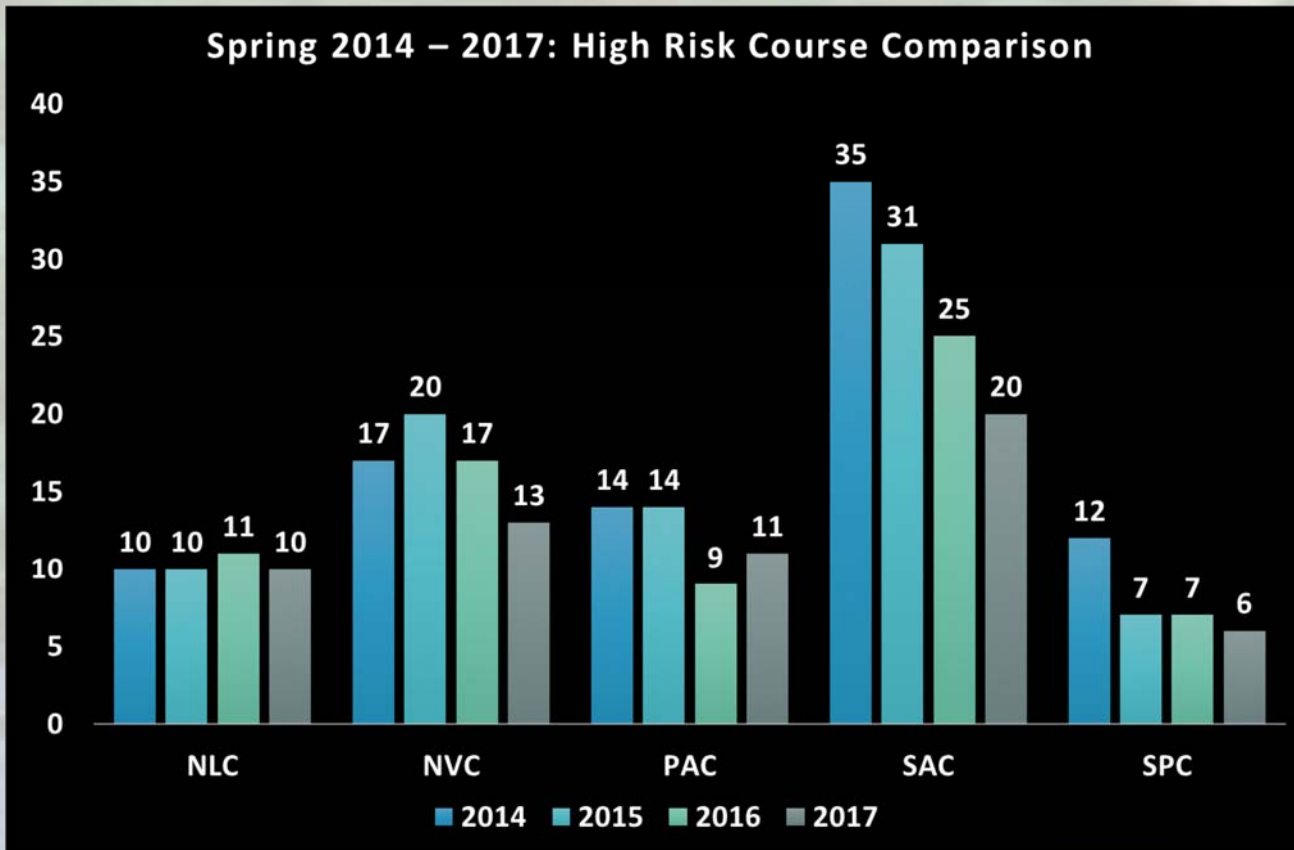


Figure 16-1 High risk course comparison of Alamo College District (ACD) institutions from spring 2014—spring 2017

HIGH RISK COURSES: SPRING 2014-2017

As displayed in *Figure 16-1*, St. Philip's College demonstrates consistent reduction of high risk courses during spring semesters 2014 through 2017. SPC subsequently achieved the lowest number of high risk courses offered by an ACD institution with only 6 courses recorded for spring 2017.

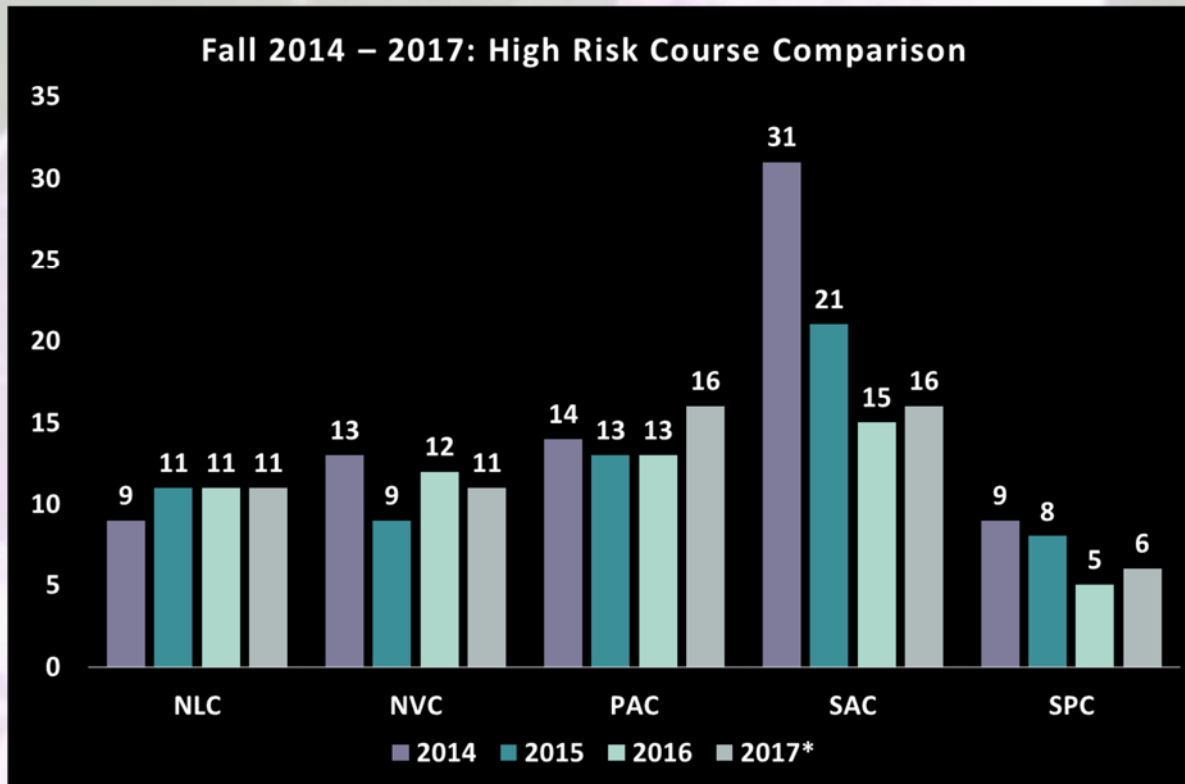


Figure 16-2 High risk course comparison of ACD institutions from fall 2014—fall 2017

HIGH RISK COURSES: FALL 2014-2017

As shown in *Figure 16-2*, St. Philip's College regularly achieves lower occurrences of high risk courses than the ACD "sister" schools for fall semesters, recording only 5 and 6 courses for fall 2016 and 2017, respectively.
