

- Founded in 1898, St. Philip's College was the first higher education institution for blacks established in the city of San Antonio.
- St. Philip's College's Culinary Arts program was the first accredited in the state of Texas by the American Culinary Federation.
- St. Philip's College is the only institution of higher education in the United States with dual designations as Historically Black and Hispanic Serving
- St. Philip's College was recognized by the American Welding Society as the first college-accredited testing facility.
