



Prerequisite Requirements

All prerequisites must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher.

Standardized Testing

All applicants are required to take a standardized test. For all Health Science Programs, applicants will be taking "The Essential Academic Skills" (TEAS) standardized exam. The TEAS is a web-based exam that helps identify students with the best chance of success in the Health Sciences field. The TEAS is a multiple-choice assessment of basic academic knowledge that covers Reading, Mathematics, Science and English language usage.

This exam may only be taken once every 6 months.

Students must register prior to taking the exam.
