Application Process

Completed application packets, including all supporting documents, are accepted in the Spring semester by the deadline of March 31. Applications are reviewed during the Spring semester for consideration to begin the OTA program in the following Fall semester.

Only applicants with complete application packets will be considered. The complete application packet should include the following:

- Completed Notice to OTA Program applicants, OTA Student Application Form, and OTA Application Checklist.
- Complete the online Shadow Program Module.
- Official transcripts from all colleges (including St. Philip's College if applicable) attended are required. An official transcript from the Registrar's office should be emailed to spc-ota@alamo.edu. The program will NOT be accepting applications by mail. A minimum 2.75 overall GPA is required.
- ATI TEAS score summary sheet. Complete the Assessment Technology Institute (ATI) The Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) standardized exam with a minimum score of 65. **SELECT THE TEST FOR ALLIED HEALTH** not Nursing.
