Selection Process:

Prospective students submitting an application to the Respiratory Care Technology Program will be selected based upon the following criteria:

1. Prerequisite Course Completion and Scoring:

Prerequisite courses will need to have completed a “C” grade or higher in every prerequisite course to be considered for the program.

Students submitting an application on or before March 31st with all prerequisites completed will be given priority status in the selection process. Students completing prerequisites in the Spring or Summer sessions may not be considered for acceptance if the program has met the enrollment capacity for a given academic year. The program selects between 24 and 30 students each academic year.

2. GPA Scoring:

Prerequisite GPA will be scored according to conventional calculation of college GPA (quality points divided by semester credit hours). The GPA will be part of the prospective student’s total score. Maximum score for this section will be 30 points for the Prerequisite GPA and 20 points for the overall GPA.

3. TEAS V Exam Scoring:

TEAS V Exam scores will be submitted with the program application. The TEAS V Adjusted Individual Total Score will be used to score this section. Maximum score for this section is 20 points.

4. Essay Scoring:

The essay entitled “Why I Have Chosen the Respiratory Care Profession” will be typed with 12 point font, double-spaced, and one page in length. Maximum score for this section will be 5 points.

Essays with grammatical/typographical errors, or that are too brief or lengthy will receive a reduction in points.

5. Interview Scoring:

The interview process will consist of multiple prewritten questions that will be scored on a 1 to 5 scale each. Maximum score for this section will be 10 points.

6. Additional Scoring Items:

Students “life experiences” will also be considered. Examples of items to provide that will be scored accordingly are, but not limited to, community service, medical work experience, ethics training, CPR, a medical terminology course, etc. Maximum score for this section will be 5 points.
